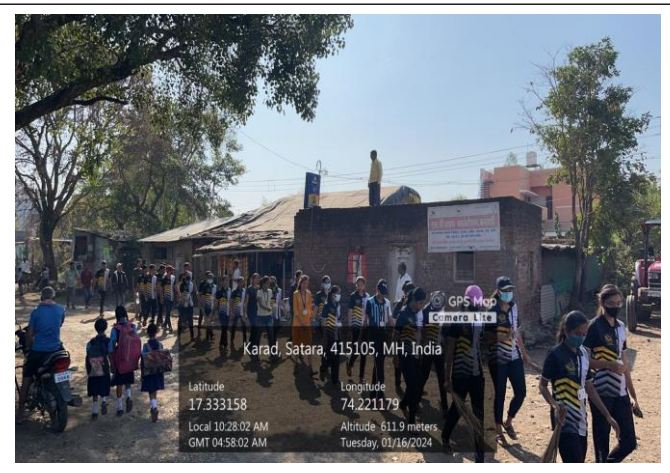
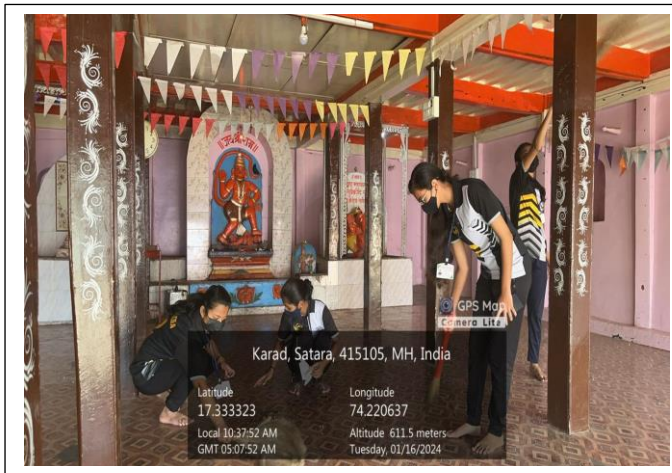

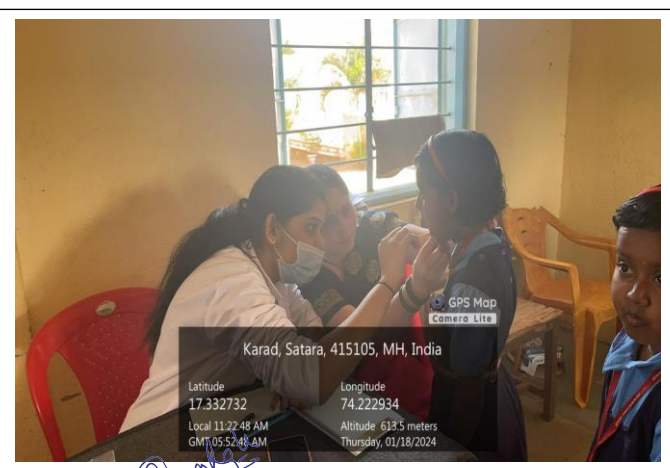


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Dental Camp : Date: 18.01.2024

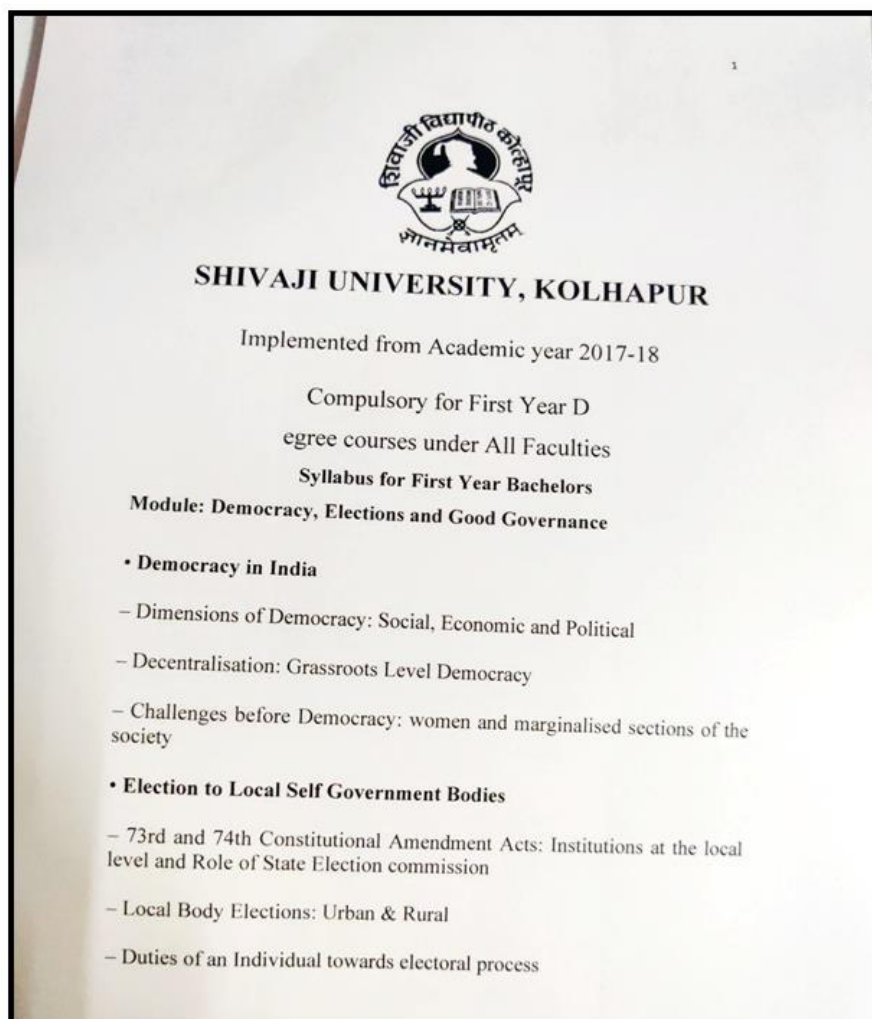

Scope: This course is designed to impart basic knowledge on important legislations related to the profession of pharmacy in India. **45 Hours**

Objectives: Upon completion of the course, the student shall be able to understand:

1. The Pharmaceutical legislations and their implications in the development and marketing of pharmaceuticals.



Item no. 2

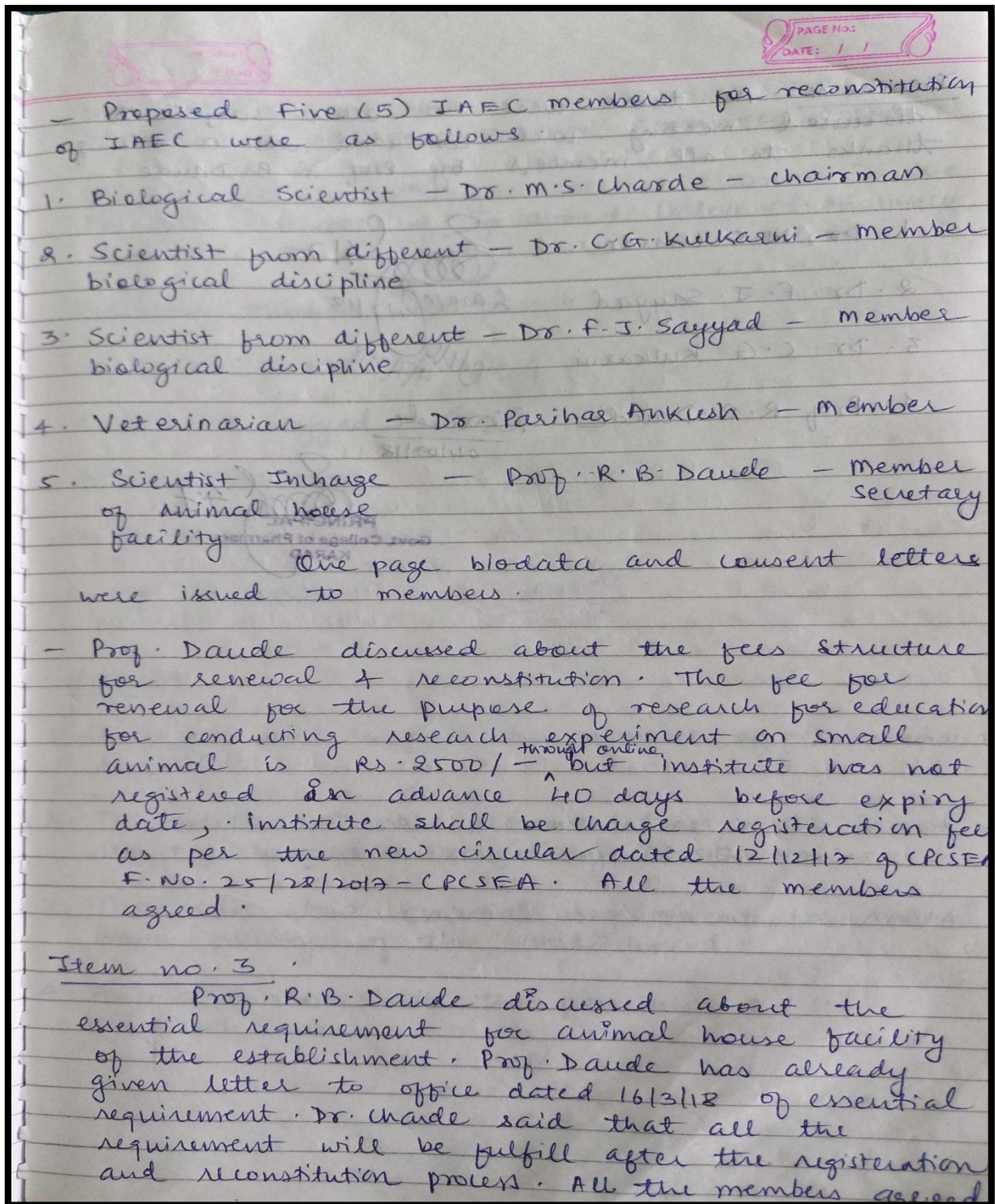
To recommend for CPCSEA Renewal of registration of the establishment and reconstitution of Institutional animal ethical committee.
